# Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing on the application by Cameco Corporation for an amendment to its Cigar Lake construction licence to extend the expiry date for an indeterminate period. The Cigar Lake Project is located near Waterbury Lake in northern Saskatchewan.

One-Day Hearing: November 1, 2007

Place: CNSC Public Hearing Room, 14<sup>th</sup> floor, 280 Slater Street, Ottawa, Ontario

Public hearings follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

The indeterminate licence period would allow Cameco Corporation to complete the mine remediation activities and subsequent construction activities. Cameco Corporation is also seeking modifications to its construction licence that are considered administrative in nature. Further amendments to the construction licence or an application for an operating licence would be subject to separate hearings.

Submissions from CNSC staff and Cameco Corporation for the Commission's hearing on the licence amendment will be available after August 31, 2007.

The public is invited to comment on Cameco's application either by oral presentation or written submission. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by October 2, 2007 at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *CNSC Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.
