



Revised Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces **that the public is now invited to intervene by way of oral presentation on Zircatec's application to produce two new types of nuclear fuel at its Fuel Fabrication Facility located in Port Hope. The hearing will take place on June 12 in Ottawa, Ontario.**

One-Day Hearing: June 12, 2008
Place: CNSC Public Hearing Room, 14th floor, 280 Slater Street, Ottawa, Ontario

The public hearing will be webcasted live via the CNSC Web site. Public hearings follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

Zircatec is already licensed to produce nuclear fuel for CANDU and research reactors. Zircatec is seeking approval to put in place two new production lines: a first line to produce fuel containing Slightly Enriched Uranium dioxide (SEU) and a second line to produce fuel containing blended dysprosium and natural uranium oxides (BDU).

The Screening Environmental Assessment Report for the proposed project, pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act* (CEAA), was approved by the Commission on February 18, 2008, following a Public Hearing held in Oshawa, Ontario on January 9, 2008.

The public is invited to comment on Zircatec's application by filing its request with the Secretary of the Commission by May 28, 2008 at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- **a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation;** and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.
