# Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing on August 29, 2008 to consider an application by GE-Hitachi Nuclear Energy Canada Inc.'s (GEH-C) to amend its operating licence for its Class 1B facility located in Peterborough, Ontario.

GEH-C requests to include in Section IV of its current operating licence the maintenance and repair activities that GEH-C carries out as a Class 1B licensee and which are described in other existing GEH-C licensing documentation. In addition, although the facility location has not changed, the mailing address did change as part of the global alliance with Hitachi on June 4, 2007 and GEH-C requests that this modification be reflected in Section IV. These modifications are considered administrative in nature or would not change the existing physical works or the physical activities at the licensed facility.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider GEH-C's application in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
