



Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing to consider an application by Cameco Corporation (Cameco) to amend its Cigar Lake construction licence.

Hearing: September 18, 2008

Place: Delta Bessborough, 601 Spadina Crescent East, Saskatoon, Saskatchewan

The public hearing will be webcasted live via the CNSC Web site. Public hearings follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

The requested licence amendment would authorize Cameco to proceed with the Cigar Lake remediation project. The application includes activities related to initiation and completion of Phases 2, 3 and 4, and a request for authorisation for further surface activities, completion of No. 2 Shaft and the continuation of the activities currently licensed.

CNSC staff and Cameco's submissions will be available after July 18, 2008 by contacting the Secretariat. The public is invited to comment on Cameco's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by August 18, 2008 at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.
