



Revised Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces a new date for Day-Two of the public hearing to consider AREVA Resources Canada Inc.'s (AREVA) application to renew its operating licence for the McClean Lake Uranium Mine and Mill Operation located in northern Saskatchewan. AREVA has requested authorization to continue its activities and to include the ongoing care and maintenance activities at the Midwest Project site, currently authorized under a separate licence. AREVA has requested a ten-year licence term. AREVA is also requesting the revocation of its Uranium Mine Site Preparation Licence for the Midwest Project.

Day Two of the public hearing will take place on April 30 instead of May 7, 2009, as originally announced. The CNSC also announces a new deadline for the public to submit a request to intervene.

The public hearing will be webcasted live via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

The public is invited to comment on AREVA's application on Hearing Day Two. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by **March 30, 2009** at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.

AREVA's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at Hearing Day One are not available on-line and must be requested through the Secretariat at the address below.
