The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in July to consider the approval of the Environmental Assessment (EA) Screening Report for Cameco Corporation's (Cameco) Key Lake Mill Services Project for the construction of the mill services facilities. The Key Lake Uranium Milling operation is located in northern Saskatchewan.

The Commission has approved the project-specific EA Guidelines in October 2008 and delegated the technical studies and the assessment of the project impact to Cameco.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing was not necessary to consider the approval of the proposed EA Screening Report.

Following the deliberations, the Commission's decision on this matter will be made available to the public on the CNSC Web site.

The Commission will consider written submissions from CNSC staff and Cameco.
