# Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing to consider the Saskatchewan Research Council (SRC)'s application for the extension of exemptions of the Gunnar and Lorado mine sites from the requirements of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act* (NSCA).

Hearing: December 10, 2009  
Place: CNSC Public Hearing Room, 14th floor, 280 Slater Street, Ottawa, Ontario  
Time: as set by the agenda, to be published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

SRC requests an extension of the current exemptions of the Gunnar and Lorado mine sites from the requirements of the NSCA until December 31, 2014 to allow the necessary environmental assessment and licensing processes for these two mine sites to follow their course.

The public is invited to observe the proceeding.
