



Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April 2010 to consider the approval of the Screening Report for AREVA Resources Canada Inc. (AREVA)'s proposed Caribou Project located at the McClean Lake Operation in northern Saskatchewan.

The purpose of the project is to extend the mining and milling activities at the McClean Lake Operation. The proposed activities are to mine the Caribou ore deposit, transport the ore to its existing mill, process the ore to produce yellowcake (a form of uranium), and manage the waste water, waste rock and tailings resulting from these activities.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider AREVA's request in this case. There is no opportunity for the public to participate. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and AREVA.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
