The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (the Commission) is providing Saskatchewan Research Council (SRC) with an opportunity to be heard on the Designated Officer Order issued for the Gunnar mine site on June 18, 2010.

Pursuant to subsection 37(6) of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act* (NSCA), the Designated Officer referred the Order to the Commission for review with the purpose to confirm, amend, revoke or replace the Order.

The Commission is proceeding with the opportunity to be heard in accordance with Part 6 of the *CNSC Rules of Procedure*. The Commission will consider the Order and CNSC staff's submission.

The opportunity to be heard on the Designated Officer Order will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

There is no opportunity for the public to intervene on this matter but the public is invited to observe the proceedings. Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be made available to the public and published on the CNSC Web site at www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca.
