To the CNSC Relicensing Committee:

Please accept this letter as a show of support for Bruce Power in its attempt to have its operating license renewed for an additional ten years.

The members of the Painters and Allied Trades of Ontario District Council 46, Locals 1494/1590 believe Bruce Power should receive its license renewal from the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission so its Bruce A and B stations can continue to provide reliable electricity to the people of Ontario, while maintaining (and creating) thousands of jobs for its employees, union members like those in IUPAT, and other contractors and suppliers. The annual economic impact of the Bruce Power operations is in excess of 4 billion dollars.
