Approximately 55% having 20 employees or less



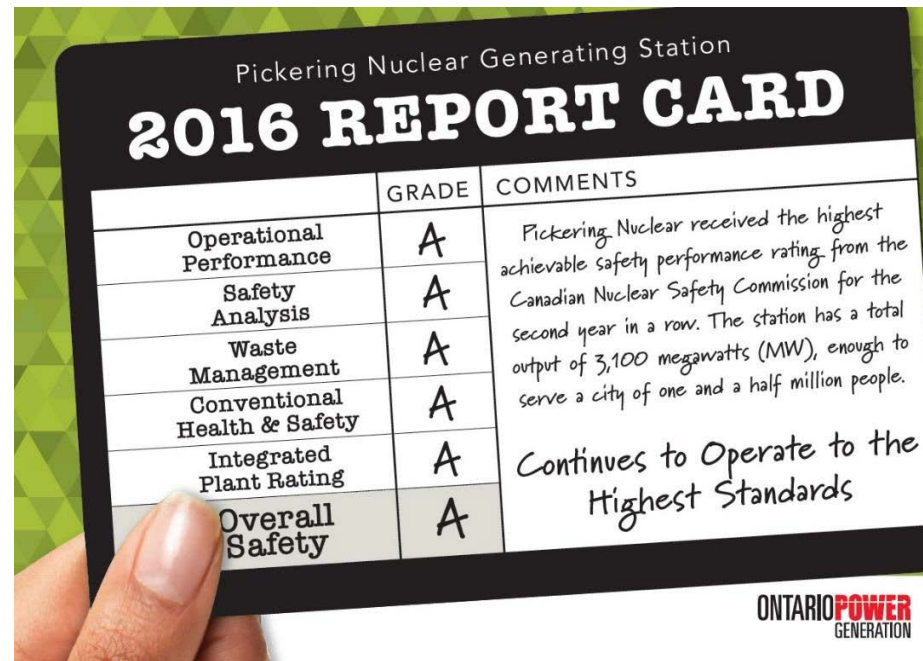
# About Us

On multiple occasions, OPG has opened its doors to community stakeholders, including the Ajax-Pickering Board of Trade, to give evidence to their focus on safety



# Commitment to Safety: APBOT Tour

- On February 1, 2018, the APBOT's Board of Directors was invited to a presentation and insightful tour of OPG's operations
- Among the information included on the tour were stats relating to Pickering Nuclear Station's operations:
  - 1) Continue operations will reduce greenhouse gas emissions by an estimated 17 million tonnes.
  - 2) 14% of Ontario's power is supplied by Pickering
  - 3) and had created 4,500 highly-skilled direct and indirect jobs in Durham Region.)
- According to Pickering's 2016 report card, for a second straight year CNSC awarded Pickering the highest safety performance rating





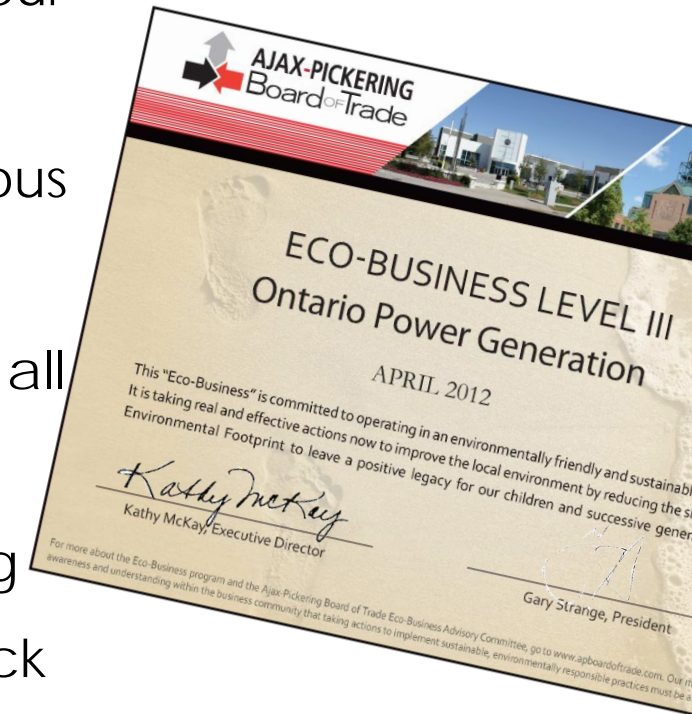
# Commitment to Safety: Emergency Preparedness Exercise

- On December 6 and 7, 2017, OPG invited more than 30 agencies to participate in a large-scale emergency preparedness exercise. APBOT was among those invited to observe
- The scenario replicated a Fukushima-scale event and brought together municipal, provincial, and federal agencies to look deeply at the procedures they have in place in the unlikely event the redundancies built into the Candu design fail.
- While such a large-scale disaster is unlikely to happen, all those involved in the exercise improve upon their preparedness
- OPG's transparency in this type of exercise also reaffirms their commitment to safety and their readiness in the event of disaster



# Commitment to the Environment: APBOT Eco-Business

- In April 2012, the Ajax-Pickering Board of Trade awarded OPG our highest level of Eco-Business certification.
- Level III Eco-Business's must have already completed the previous two levels and must be able to tick 80% of the boxes on our 50 item long Level III checklist, including: switching to LED lights for all fixtures where available, investing in a water treatment process that reduces water consumption and reclaims heat, eliminating all aerosol cleaners and aerosol-propelled substances, and track water usage and report on reductions in the amount used/consumed over time to understand how much is being used and how much you are saving.



# Pickering Nuclear's Economic Impact



- Continued operation of the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station is associated with 4,500 direct and indirect jobs in Durham Region
- It would also put \$1.54 billion per year into Ontario's GDP
- Pickering Nuclear supports an annual average of 140 grass roots community initiatives
