CNSC Staff Integrated Safety Assessment of Canadian Nuclear Power Plants for 2011

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a meeting on August 15, 2012, during which CNSC staff will present their *CNSC Staff Integrated Safety Assessment of Canadian Nuclear Power Plants for 2011* (2011 NPP Report). This report assesses the safety performance at each NPP, makes generic observations and identifies trends for the nuclear power industry as a whole.

The 2011 NPP Report also summarizes the actions taken by NPP licensees and CNSC staff during 2011 in response to the Fukushima accident. The CNSC concluded as a result of the 2011 Fukushima review that Canadian NPPs continue to be safe and that the risk posed to the health and safety of Canadians or to the environment continues to be small. CNSC staff has also verified that all Canadian NPPs are located far from tectonic plate boundaries and that the threat of a major earthquake at a Canadian NPP is negligible.
