



Notice of Adjournment of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces the adjournment of the public hearing that was scheduled to take place on June 18, 2014 to consider the application by Cameco Corporation (Cameco) for a 10-year licence for its Millennium Mine project, a proposed underground uranium mine located approximately 600 kilometres north of Saskatoon.

Cameco informed the Commission that it does not wish to proceed with the licensing of the Millennium Mine project at this time, due to current economic conditions.

Should Cameco request, at a later date, the Commission to consider the application for a licence for the Millennium Mine project, a Notice of Public Hearing will be issued and the public will be invited to participate.
