



Revised Notice of Hearing

July 3, 2014

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in July 2014 to consider Hydro-Québec's application to amend the operating licence for the Gentilly-2 Nuclear Generating Station (NGS), located in Bécancour, Québec.

Hydro-Québec is asking the Commission to amend its operating licence to reflect the current defueled core state and the transition to safe storage of the Gentilly-2 NGS. These administrative amendments would remove licence conditions which no longer apply, and modify other licence conditions to reflect the decreased risk presented by the current state of the station. The Commission will consider Hydro-Québec's application by way of written submissions, in a closed session.

Members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter, or possess information that may be useful to the Commission's decision-making are invited to comment in writing on Hydro-Québec's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by July 21, 2014, directly online at nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/the-commission/intervention, or through the coordinates below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments
- name, address and telephone number of the requester

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page, if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public, upon request to the Secretariat.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings*, including *Reasons for Decision*, will be published on the CNSC website and made available to the public.

Hydro-Québec's and CNSC staff's submissions are available in both official languages. These documents are not downloadable. To obtain the submissions, a request must be made to the Secretariat at the address below, or directly to the website.
