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# *Notice of Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing on July 14, 2014 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to extend its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence (PROL) by 12 months for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (NGS). The Darlington NGS is located in the municipality of Clarington, on the north shore of Lake Ontario.

The current licence for the Darlington NGS is valid until December 31, 2014. The proposed licence amendment is to extend the current licence by 12 months, to December 31, 2015, with the same terms and conditions as the current licence. This will allow OPG additional time to provide more comprehensive documentation, reflect new CNSC expectations and facilitate public engagement in the upcoming hearing process for a long-term licence, including refurbishment.

The CNSC advertised a [Notice of Public Hearing for the Darlington NGS back on March 10, 2014](#). If OPG's current request for an extension is approved, the public hearing originally advertised for November 2014 will be deferred.

Following the deliberations in a closed session and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC website and made available to the public.
