# *Notice of Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August 2014, to consider Nordion (Canada) Inc.'s application to transfer their *Nuclear Substance Processing Facility Operating Licence* (NSPFOL) for their nuclear substance processing facility, located in Kanata, Ontario.

Nordion is asking the Commission to transfer its NSPFOL to a new corporate identity of the same name following its acquisition by STHI Holding Corp. (Sterigenics). Nordion identified that the changes to the corporate structure do not impact operational and management structure and will not result in any changes on its operational organization or its obligations for compliance with the applicable licences, regulations and the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this request from Nordion (Canada) Inc. as the requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to health, safety or environmental protection that would warrant being considered in the context of a public hearing. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Nordion (Canada) Inc.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC website and made available to the public.
