# *Notice of Public Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public hearing on the application by SRB Technologies (Canada) Inc. (SRB) to renew, for a period of 10 years, its nuclear substance processing facility operating licence for its facility located in Pembroke, Ontario.

The current licence authorizes SRB to operate a tritium processing facility, which manufactures self-luminous exit signs.

Hearing: May 13 and 14, 2015  
Place: Best Western Pembroke Inn & Conference Centre, 1 International Drive,  
Pembroke, Ontario  
Time: As set by the agenda published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcast live and then archived for a period of 90 days on the CNSC website, [nuclearsafety.gc.ca](http://nuclearsafety.gc.ca).

Members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter, or information that may be useful to the Commission, are invited to comment on SRB's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by April 13, 2015, either online – at [nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/the-commission/intervention](http://nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/the-commission/intervention) – or via the coordinates below. Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, **the request must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- name, address and telephone number of the requester

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

SRB's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations will be available after March 13, 2015. These documents are not downloadable. To obtain them, a request must be made to the Secretariat at the address below or directly from the CNSC website, [nuclearsafety.gc.ca](http://nuclearsafety.gc.ca). Agendas, hearing transcripts and information on the hearing process are available on the website.
