



Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in March 2016 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to amend its Waste Facility Operating Licence for the Darlington Waste Management Facility, located on the site of the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station in Clarington, ON.

OPG requested the following amendments:

- the removal of a licence condition that has been fulfilled
- a modification to the operational performance reporting transmittal period
- an update to the format of the licence to align with the CNSC standardized licence conditions

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this application. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to the protection of health, safety, security or the environment that would warrant being considered in a public hearing. The Commission will consider written submissions from OPG and CNSC staff.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations in a closed session and Commission decision on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, Including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available to the public on request.
