



Notice of Hearing in Writing

September 8, 2020

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing based on written submissions to consider an application from SRB Technologies (Canada) Inc. (SRBT) requesting acceptance of a revised preliminary decommissioning plan and a revised financial guarantee for the SRBT tritium processing facility in Pembroke, Ontario. The financial guarantee assures funding for the current and future decommissioning costs, including the long-term management of waste generated by the operation. SRBT is located in Pembroke, Ontario. The current licence authorizes SRBT to operate a tritium processing facility and to possess, transfer, use, process, manage and store the required nuclear substances.

Pursuant to Rule 3 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure* (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules in order to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from SRBT and CNSC staff, as well as written interventions from members of the public. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on SRBT's application. A decision from the Commission is anticipated in October 2020.

Under Rule 19, persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment in writing on SRBT's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **October 9, 2020**, using the [online request form](#) or the contact information below. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or upon request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. To ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

The hearing submissions from SRBT and CNSC staff are available on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca or upon request to the Secretariat. Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a record of decision will be published on the CNSC website and made available upon request.
