# *Revised Notice of Public Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces changes to the date for the public hearing on Cameco Corporation's application for a 10-year renewal of its Nuclear Fuel Facility Operating Licence for the Port Hope Conversion Facility in Port Hope, ON. The current licence expires February 28, 2017.

The public hearing will now take place on November 8 and 9, 2016, instead of November 9 and 10 as originally announced.
