Dear Sirs,

I am responding to a request made in OPG's letter of February 3, 2020 to Ms. Riendeau for clarification of the record of decision 19-H104 that was issued by the Commission on July 18, 2019 regarding revisions to the OPG Darlington NGS Integrated Implementation Plan (IIP). This request was recently brought to my attention, as Commission Secretary. In turn, I brought the matter to the attention of the panel of the Commission which rendered the decision, for its instructions. OPG has sought confirmation of the applicability of this decision to all 4 Darlington units, since OPG is not certain if part of the decision may apply only to Unit 2.

The panel of the Commission has confirmed on December 7, 2020, as was intended by the submissions made by OPG and CNSC staff on the record for this matter, that the decision on its face applies to all 4 units. This does not, in the Commission's estimation, require additional rationale, a change to the record of decision or a reopening of this hearing, as the decision's applicability should be understood on its plain terms.

A copy of this confirmation will be added to the record in this matter, to reflect that the Commission has provided this clarification without reconsidering the matter or needing to reopen the hearing.
