The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) offered funding support, under its Participant Funding Program (PFP), for CNSC meetings on matters of regulatory interest and process to facilitate a meeting on October 14, 2017 between the Métis Nation of Ontario - Region 6 Consultation Committee and CNSC staff. The meeting was to discuss the CNSC's Independent Environmental Monitoring Program (IEMP) and CNSC Regulated Facilities in the Port Hope Region.

The information gathered from the meeting will be included in a relevant Commission member document, to bring any valuable information directly to the Commission. The deadline for submitting the PFP application to the CNSC was September 21, 2017.

Background

PFP support for CNSC meetings on matters of regulatory interest was made available by the CNSC to:

- enhance Aboriginal and stakeholder participation in the CNSC's environmental assessment and licensing processes, and
- help stakeholders bring valuable information to the Commission.

A Funding Review Committee (FRC), independent from the CNSC, was established to review the funding application received by the CNSC's PFP Administrator, and to make recommendations on the allocation of funding to the applicant.

The FRC member was Mr. Bruce Young, retired Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency Director.

The CNSC received one PFP application requesting \$2,521.74, and this was reviewed by the FRC.
