Dear Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission,

This is my written intervention, I live very close to the BWXT uranium plant and was very upset and scared to find that such a plant is in my neighbourhood and is located in the city of Toronto. I found out just this just year about BWXT as previous the signage on the uranium property was listed as GE Hitachi. This neighbourhood is full of families with children that go to school nearby and play in the parks within the area. This plant does not belong in such a dense residential neighbourhood in the city.

I feel the following:

I would like for BWXT to move, they are no longer welcome in the community.

I want this uranium plant shut down. It is dangerous and releases toxins into the air that are very harmful to everyone. Also there is nothing available to the public about emergency plans and if they are insured.

What is the transportation route? Do people living along the transportation route have a right to know nuclear material and radioactive products are travelling next to their communities and over their waterways? Are people notified in BWXT's public consultation if they are living along a heavily uranium route shipping tones of uranium per day in powder or pellet form?
