
With a fuel manufacturing plant in Port Hope and a metal fabrication plant in Cobourg, Cameco is an essential part of our local economy. Cameco is one of the largest employers in our community, and it provides meaningful, skilled jobs to many of our constituents.

Further, Cameco Fuel Manufacturing does important work on the front of nuclear technology. Cameco is one of two fuel fabrication suppliers serving Canada's reactor fleet and is the largest Canadian-based fabricator of zirconium reactor components for CANDU reactors around the world.
