



Notice of Hearing

December 8, 2015

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in December 2015 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to amend the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for its Pickering Nuclear Generating Station, located in Pickering, ON.

The proposed amendments include:

- replacing CNSC regulatory document RD-310, *Safety Analysis for Nuclear Power Plants*, with CNSC regulatory document REGDOC-2.4.1, *Deterministic Safety Analysis*
- replacing CNSC regulatory standard S-294, *Probabilistic Safety Assessment (PSA) for Nuclear Power Plants*, with CNSC regulatory document REGDOC-2.4.2, *Probabilistic Safety Assessment (PSA) for Nuclear Power Plants*

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this application. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to health, safety or environmental protection that would warrant being considered in a public hearing. The Commission will consider written submissions from OPG and CNSC staff.

The submissions are available by sending a request to the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations in a closed session and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, Including Reasons for Decision* will be published at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available to the public upon request.
