



Notice of Hearing in Writing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing based on written submissions in July 2019 to consider an application from the Saskatchewan Research Council (SRC) to amend its Non-Power Reactor Operating Licence for its SLOWPOKE-2 reactor and associated facilities. SRC's SLOWPOKE-2 facility is located in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

The current licence authorizes SRC to operate the SLOWPOKE-2 facility and to transition the reactor into a safe state. The proposed licence amendment would authorize SRC to decommission the facility.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure* (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules in order to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from SRC and CNSC staff, as well as written interventions from members of the public. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on SRC's application.

Pursuant to rule 19 of the Rules, persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment, in writing, on SRC's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **June 25, 2019**, using the [online request form](#) or the contact information below. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Decision* will be published on the CNSC website and made available on request.
